**Tuesday-Friday

SESSION 1: Warm Sunny Beaches & Oceans of Art

June 28 - July 1 9:00 am - 12:30 pm ages 6-10

This is a week to kick back, relax and enjoy the water. Squirt bottle painting, tennis ball painting, dipped link painting and more – lots of ways to use water and paint to create incredible art. We'll have fun with these unconventional painting techniques and then use these paintings for backgrounds for other projects. Drawings and paintings could include fish and other sea creatures, underwater treasures, palm trees and beautiful beaches.

SESSION 2: Cartooning - Traditional

June 28 - July 1 1:30 pm - 5:00 pm ages 7-13

This week is all about drawing! Each day we'll learn to draw several different cartoon characters. We'll include some classic favorites like Mickey, Minnie or Piglet as well as fantasy aliens, rockets, and robots. In previous camps our drawings have included Star Wars, Garfield, Cars, Toy Story, Monsters, Inc., Calvin and Hobbes, Snoopy, Shrek, Digimon, Hello Kitty, Goofy, Bugs Bunny, Sponge Bob and Nemo. We'll learn about animation and make thaumatropes (spinning discs). Help us plan – when you register tell us what characters you really want to draw!

SESSION 3: Cartooning - Pokémon

July 6 - 9 9:00 am - 12:30 pm ages 7-13

This cartooning camp will focus on Pokémon characters. Pokémon (Pocket Monsters) are cute, strange, powerful and so much fun to play with. This week everyone will become a Pokémon trainer and draw Pikachu, Venusaur, Chikorita, Squirtle, Mewto, Ponya and others – tell us your favorite Pokémon characters when you register. We'll also create our own version of a Poké Ball. We'll be drawing, painting and working in 3D, Shrinky Dinks and more! Join us for a week of supernatural powers and magical adventures.

SESSION 4: Alice in Wonderland Tea Party Fun

July 6 - 9 1:30 pm - 5:00 pm ages 6- 9

Anything is possible – it's a week of imagination, creativity, fun and believing "six impossible things before breakfast". Younger campers will enjoy tea party fun, the Mad Hatter, White Rabbit, Cheshire Cat and Alice. We'll draw and paint imaginary scenes, make teacups and work with clay. Older campers will explore a slightly more "mature" version of Alice in Wonderland incorporating some of Tim Burton's (think Nightmare Before Christmas and the new Alice in Wonderland movie) style and attitude. Playing cards are guaranteed to turn into amazing useful works of art (older campers)!

SESSION 5: Classic Camp - Art Adventures

July 12 - 15 9:00 am - 12:30 pm ages 6- 10

This week will be filled with traditional camp projects featuring Sit Upons, Birdhouses, Gods-Eye Yarn Designs, Friendship Bracelets, Pony Bead Creatures, Gimp, Leather and S'Mores. We'll learn campfire songs and weather permitting we'll create some art outdoors. We'll be drawing and painting animals and landscapes complete with tents and bears!

Our teachers look forward to Summer Art Camps as much as the kids who come to our camps. We work hard, play hard and have a lot of fun!

SESSION 6: Discover Mexico

July 12 - 15 1:30 pm - 5:00 pm ages 10-15

Mexico is filled with amazing art and artists. We'll look at the work of Diego Rivera and Frida Kahlo for inspiration as well as Tin Art, Oaxacan Animals, Molasses, Tree of Life, and Day of the Dead Skeletons. Older campers will be working with clay to create Mexican markets (Mercados) filled with miniature fruits and vegetables. They will also be sculpting Milagros – small charms believed to have great powers. Younger campers will be using clay to sculpt Aztec Suns.

SESSION 7: Summer Garden - Birds, Butterflies, Bugs & Flowers

July 19 - 22 9:00 am - 12:30 pm ages 10-15

It's time to enjoy summer – we'll be using nature for inspiration all week. We'll paint flowers on canvas with acrylic paints and draw incredible designs based on butterflies and bugs. Younger campers will make friendly caterpillars out of socks and clay creatures. Older campers will learn how to "paint" with paper pulp. Older campers will also concentrate on developing their color mixing skills and painting techniques.

Camp Information:

Camp weeks have different themes but in each camp we will stress the process of art rather than trying to achieve a perfect result. By working in a supportive environment we'll encourage each other to try new things. We'll take time to really look at what we're creating and spend some time playing with different art materials.

Camp descriptions may change somewhat depending on the interests of each group of campers and the length of time projects take to complete.

Camp Philosophy:

The camps will be run by Sharon Cavanaugh, Doris Mrugala, Cathy Levesque, and Brenda Lyons teachers at Connecticut ART School, South Windsor. Our goal is to teach children how to use art as a positive creative outlet for fun, self-expression and to build self-esteem.

We have been offering summer art camps since 2002 - we take great pride in our camps and continually work to create fun, challenging, and inspiring projects.

Camp Location:

All camps, evening drawing classes, Friday workshops and mini camps are held at **1730 Ellington Road, South Windsor at Connecticut ART School**. We will work outdoors, weather permitting, for some projects. We have portable easels and mats that we can bring outside and a nice grassy area to work.

We will also be working in the school classrooms which are air conditioned. It's great to have the option to work both indoors and out so we can easily adjust to the weather and the type of project we're working on.

Class size is limited. *We suggest you register early to reserve a space.*

Camps fill quickly so please include alternative choices on the registration form. We will contact you if your first choice is full. Spaces will be filled according to the date registration and deposit is received.

Camp Schedule and Cost:

Camp sessions are 3.5 hours a day, Monday through Thursday. There are both morning and afternoon camps. Because of the 4th of July holiday sessions 3 & 4 meet Tuesday through Friday.

Please bring a water bottle and nut-free snack each day and wear clothes you can get paint on.

Registration is \$160 per session

We are pleased to offer a \$10 discount per camp for additional family members or additional camps - the discount will apply to each camp and each camper. (Each camp will be \$150).

A non-refundable \$80 deposit is due with your registration. Balance is due two weeks before the start of your session. We can not hold a space without a deposit. Since enrollment is limited camp fees will not be refunded unless there is a child on the waiting list who can fill your spot.

Six campers are required for a camp to begin. There are no refunds or makeups for misses classes.

Note: We reserve the right to refuse enrollment as necessary. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and students who do not comply will not be allowed to continue. Any remaining tuition is non-refundable.

Evening Drawing Classes, Friday Workshops and Mini Camps:

Full tuition must be paid when registering. We can't hold a spot without payment. Since space is limited we can not offer any refunds or makeups.

We require a minimum of 6 students for summer drawing classes, maximum 12 (8 for Mini Camps).
