Session 1: June 23 - June 26

9:00 - 12:30 pm **60's and 70's Mania** ages 6-9

Celebrate the 60's and 70's with flower power art. We'll draw and decorate Volkswagen vans, trolls, peace symbols, go go boots, smiley faces, and pet rocks. We'll look at op art, Andy Warhol's pop art and create some of our own. Fabric and Sculpey clay will be used to make wearable art!

Session 2: June 23- June 26

1:30 - 5:00 pm **Webkinz® Fun** ages 6-10

Come play with us! These cute, cuddly pets are hard to resist. This week we'll draw a variety of Webkinz®. We'll also draw and paint special places for them, make some fashion or home accessories, and use Sculpey clay or Shrinky Dink to make them some friends. We'll begin each day with by creating our version of a Webkinz® trading card. All Webkinz® are invited to join us during camp. All registered campers will receive a Webkinz® figurine. Session 3: June 30 - July 3

9:00 - 12:30 pm **Cartoon Animation** ages 7-11

This week is all about drawing! Each day we'll learn to draw several different cartoon characters. We'll include some classic favorites like Mickey, Minnie or Piglet as well as fantasy aliens, rockets, and robots. In previous camps our drawings have included Star Wars, Garfield, Cars, Toy Story, Monsters, Inc., Calvin and Hobbes, Snoopy, Shrek, Digimon, Hello Kitty, Goofy, Bugs Bunny, Sponge Bob and Nemo. This summer we'll draw a variety of characters and learn about animation. We'll make thaumatropes (spinning discs) and flip books to tell our stories. Help us plan – when you register tell us what characters you really want to draw!

Travel with us through Africa as we visit elephants, tigers, giraffes, lions and cheetahs. These beautiful and interesting animals will provide the inspiration for our drawings and paintings. We'll pick one to make out of Sculpey clay. This week we'll also make masks or warrior shields, traditional African dolls, and jewelry. The art, culture, animals and landscape of Africa is amazing. Come explore and create with us!

Come with us on a trip following historic Route 66, the inspiration for the movie Cars. We'll make lots of stops between Chicago and Los Angeles visiting strange and unusual roadside attractions. Did you know there is a Wigwam Motel in Arizona or that Collinsville, Illinois is the home of the World's Largest Catsup bottle? These crazy attractions, and many more, will provide inspiration for our drawings, paintings and 3D works of art. We'll even create our own version of Cadillac Ranch – an ever changing art display of graffiti covered cars.

This week we'll create regal beetles and learn about their strange and interesting history. We'll look at Egyptian art and draw pharaohs. We'll create miniature wrapped mummies with a sarcophagus sculpture (mummy case). More creations will include canopic jars (with Sculpey clay), amulets, and hieroglyphic cartouche pendants with our names.

Sunset Celebration takes place at Mallory Square in Key West, Florida every evening. It's a multicultural experience featuring artists, street performers, food and a chance to honor the day. We'll paint beautiful sunsets, boats and palm trees. We'll also draw crocodiles and chickens – beautiful chickens roam free on the streets of Key West. We'll paint on coconuts or make Sculpey clay creatures. We'll look at beautiful lighthouses, Ernest Hemingway's home, conch shells, and key limes for inspiration.

Back by popular demand - American Girl Dolls explore the past and enjoy the present. They teach us about history and the challenges and excitement of living during those times. They also celebrate being a girl, individuality, and imagination. This week is inspired by the dolls, their stories, their fashion, pets, and adventures. We'll be busy drawing, painting, creating, and learning - if you have an American Girl Doll she's welcome to join you at camp.

Camp Sessions - camps are offered in the morning from 9:00 - 12:30 pm and afternoons from 1:30 - 5:00 pm, **Monday - Thursday**. All camps include drawing, painting and high quality craft projects, all materials are included. Campers bring their own snack and water bottle. This summer there are some variations in the ages - 6-9, 6-10, 7-11 and 10-14 years old. We have special Friday Mini Camps for 5 year olds and Friday drawing classes for 6-12 year olds.

Our teachers look forward to Summer Art Camps as much as the kids who come to our camps. We work hard, play hard and have a lot of fun!



Summer Drawing Classes and Mini Camps:

Full tuition must be paid when registering. We can't hold a spot without payment. Since these are limited sessions we can not offer any refunds or makeups.

We require a minimum of 6 students for summer drawing classes, maximum 12.

Mini Camps require a minimum of 6 students, maximum 8.

Camp Information:

Camp weeks have different themes but in each camp we will stress the process of art rather than trying to achieve a perfect result. By working in a supportive environment we'll encourage each other to try new things. We'll take time to really look at what we're creating and spend some time playing with different art materials.

Camp descriptions may change somewhat depending on the interests of each group of campers and the length of time projects take to complete.

Camp Philosophy:

The camps will be run by Sharon Cavanaugh, Doris Mrugala, Charlie Margolis, and Cathy Levesque, teachers at Connecticut ART School, South Windsor. Our goal is to teach children how to use art as a positive creative outlet for fun, self-expression and to build self-esteem.

We have been offering summer art camps since 2002 - we take great pride in our camps and continually work to create fun, challenging, and inspiring projects.

Camp Location:

All camps, summer drawing classes, and mini camps are held at 1730 Ellington Road, South Windsor at Connecticut ART School. We will work outdoors, weather permitting, for some projects. We have portable easels and mats that we can bring outside and a nice grassy area to work.

We will also be working in the school classrooms which are air conditioned. It's great to have the option to work both indoors and out so we can easily adjust to the weather and the type of project we're working on.

Class size is limited. *We suggest you register early to reserve a space.*

Camps fill quickly so please include alternative choices on the registration form. We will contact you if your first choice is full. Spaces will be filled according to the date registration and deposit is received.

Camp Schedule and Cost:

Camp sessions are 3.5 hours a day, Monday through Thursday. There are both morning and afternoon camps.

Since we will be outdoors we strongly suggest your child wear sunscreen and insect repellent.

Please bring a water bottle and snack each day and wear clothes you can get paint on.

Registration is \$150 per week

We are pleased to offer a \$10 discount per camp for additional family members or additional camps - the discount will apply to each camp and each camper. (Each camp will be \$140).

A non-refundable \$75 deposit is due with your registration. Balance is due two weeks before the start of your session. We can not hold a space without a deposit. Since enrollment is limited camp fees will not be refunded unless there is a child on the waiting list who can fill your spot.

Six campers are required for a camp to begin.

There are no refunds or makeups for misses classes.

Note: We reserve the right to refuse enrollment as necessary. Disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and students who do not comply will not be allowed to continue. Any remaining tuition is non-refundable.
